

Franklin University

Academic Regalia

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the 13th and 14th centuries. The hoods are thought to be carried over from the times when the monks who operated universities wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe also may have been necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in the 18th century. In 1895, a conference of various university officials adopted a universal code of design and color, which has undergone numerous revisions in subsequent years.

Robe styles vary for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees. The width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increases with each advanced degree. The color of the velvet border on the hood indicates the type of advanced degree achieved.

Honor Cords

Gold signifies summa cum laude, 3.80 or above cumulative grade point average.

Light blue signifies magna cum laude, 3.60-3.79 cumulative grade point average.

White signifies cum laude, 3.40-3.59 cumulative grade point average.

To qualify for these honors, students must complete a minimum of 60 cumulative trimester hours in baccalaureate coursework or 30 trimester hours in associate coursework at Franklin University.

Red signifies transfer achievement, 3.40 or above cumulative grade point average.

Because a large percentage of students transfer from other institutions, those earning a bachelor's degree with fewer than 60 trimester hours from Franklin University and fewer than 30 trimester hours for an associate's degree are eligible for transfer achievement honors.
