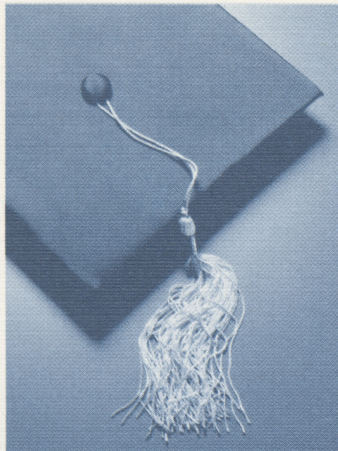

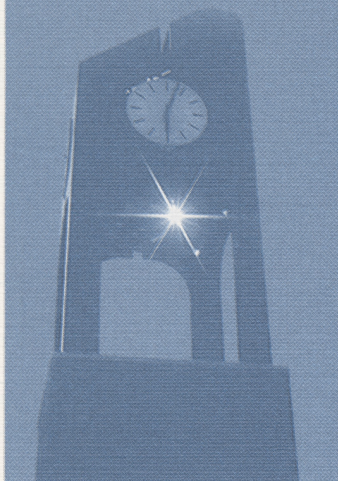

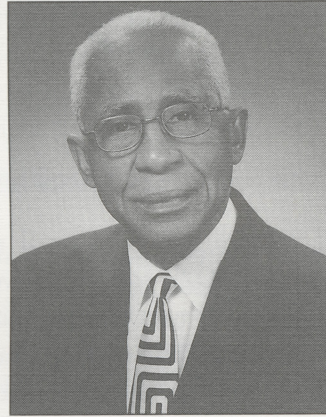
Celebrating a century of excellence in education (1902-2002), Franklin University is an independent, not-for-profit metropolitan institution of higher education. Recognized as one of the top specialty business institutions in the nation based on its academic reputation, Franklin University enables working adults to achieve their professional and personal goals by offering applied majors at the undergraduate and graduate levels.

Annually, nearly 8,000 students attend the University. Approximately 90 percent of the University's students are employed, with ages ranging from 18 to 75. The average age of our undergraduate students is 32; 35 for graduate students. The University is supported independently by tuition and the generous contributions of alumni, friends and the greater Columbus community.

Franklin University is accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools (NCA); the International Assembly for Collegiate and Business Education (IACBE); and the National League for Nursing (NLN).

About the Keynote Speaker

Rev. Leon L. Troy Sr. was born in Cleveland and attended schools in Toledo, graduating from Scott High School. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Toledo, his Bachelor of Divinity from Oberlin Graduate School of Theology, and his M.D. from Vanderbilt University in



Nashville. He has studied at the San Francisco Theological Seminary and received an honorary degree from Ohio Dominican College. He also was the recipient of the 1997 Temple Israel Humanitarian of the Year Award.

Rev. Troy has held four pastorates in the state of Ohio. He was part of the First Baptist Church in Oxford and the Ebenezer Baptist Church in Sandusky, where he instituted a Head Start Program. As a result of this program, 10 other Head Start Programs were developed throughout the city and the country by other agencies. In Warren, Rev. Troy served as pastor for 11 years at the Second Baptist Church. While there, he was elected the President of the Ohio Baptist General Convention — the youngest person to be elected president. And since August 1975, he has been Pastor of the historical Second Baptist Church in Columbus.

Appointed by former Columbus Mayor Dana Rinehart, Rev. Troy served as Special Assistant to the Mayor on Community Affairs. He was responsible for aiding and assisting citizens of Columbus or special interests groups with particular concerns or interests. In addition, he has dedicated 25 years of leadership to the United Negro College Fund and received the United Negro College Fund's Distinguished Service Award. Rev. Troy serves on many boards and committees, including The Columbus Volunteer Board, the Employment Relations Task Force, Human Services in Franklin County, and the Shelter for the Homeless. And, he was recently appointed to the Columbus Board of Education.

Rev. Troy is the founder of the House of Troy Foundation, which specializes in health care, education and family issues for the housing development of African-American males.

Robert L. Bailey Teaching Award

Each trimester, graduating students are asked to identify one undergraduate or one graduate faculty member who had the most significant influence on them throughout their educational experience at Franklin University. These faculty members are honored with the Robert L. Bailey Teaching Award.

Students select professors who have challenged them intellectually and guided them in finding the significance of the course content as it relates to them both professionally and personally.

Each trimester more than 100 faculty members are identified by the graduates, clearly showing the magnitude of the educational experience at Franklin University.

The graduate and undergraduate faculty members receiving the most nominations are identified for this honor. These faculty members also receive a monetary award.

These awards are funded through an endowment established by State Auto Insurance Companies in recognition of Robert L. Bailey, who served State Auto for 28 years in various positions, including President, CEO and Chairman, until his retirement in December 2000. Bailey also is a past Chairman and current member of Franklin University's Board of Trustees.



Undergraduate Program

Graduate Program

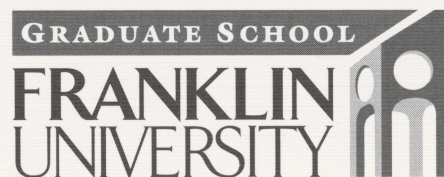

Academic Regalia

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the 13th and 14th centuries. The hoods are thought to be carried over from the times when the monks who operated universities wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe also may have been necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in the 18th century. In 1895, a conference of various university officials adopted a universal code of design and color, which has undergone numerous revisions in subsequent years.

Robe styles vary for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees. The width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increases with each advanced degree. The color of the velvet border on the hood indicates the type of advanced degree achieved.

Undergraduate Honor Cords

Gold signifies summa cum laude, 3.90 or higher cumulative grade point average.

White signifies magna cum laude, 3.70 - 3.89 cumulative grade point average.

Red signifies cum laude, 3.50 - 3.69 cumulative grade point average.

To qualify for these honors, students must complete a minimum of 40 cumulative semester hours in baccalaureate coursework or 30 semester hours in associate coursework at Franklin University.
