Franklin University

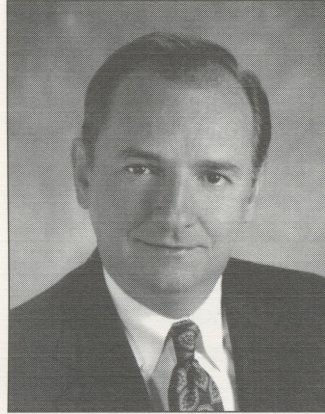

About the Keynote Speaker



Dr. Albert Lorenzo is the President of Macomb Community College in Warren, Michigan. Macomb Community College was the first college to join our Community College Alliance (CCA) Program.

Through its CCA Program, Franklin University offers

students from community colleges across the nation and in Canada the opportunity to complete their bachelor's degree through a combination of on-site and online courses.

From the time Lorenzo assumed his office, he has helped Macomb grow to become one of America's largest multi-campus community colleges and the sixth largest grantor of associate degrees in the United States.

Lorenzo began his career in public accounting, but turned his interests to higher education. He joined Macomb's staff as an assistant professor of Accounting, and later served as the College's Business Manager, Controller and Vice President for Business before becoming Macomb's fourth President in 1979. He has a Bachelor's degree in Accounting, a Master's in Business Administration and a Doctorate in Administration.

Lorenzo has served on several corporate boards and chaired the Commission of New Directions for Michigan's Community Colleges. He also is a member of the National Advisory Panel for The College Board.

Lorenzo has taught in the fields of Accounting, Management and Educational Administration. His pragmatic approaches to leadership, planning and organizational development issues have been the focus of a number of publications and national speaking engagements. Graduate Program

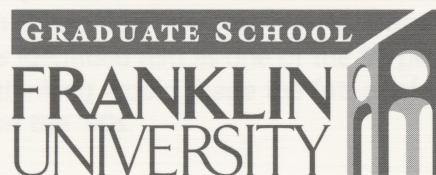
Since 1993, Franklin University's MBA Program has addressed real-world issues facing professionals and corporations. The University's evening MBA Program has become the leading MBA in central Ohio with more than 500 students enrolled. Because of its success, Franklin will be piloting an Online MBA in the fall.

From the strength of its MBA, the University's Graduate School has evolved to offer a number of graduate-level options of true Franklin quality:

- A Master of Science in Marketing & Communication offers a degree rigorous, yet responsive to the needs of marketing and communication professionals, with extensive coursework that addresses issues from research to theory, and from persuasive strategy to multicultural communication.
- A Master of Science in Human Services Management provides human services professionals with an education that gives them the essential skills necessary to manage service in today's complicated human services industries.

Academic Regalia

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the 13th and 14th centuries. The hoods are thought to be carried over from the times when the monks who operated universities wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe also may have been necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in the 18th century. In 1895, a conference of various university officials adopted a universal code of design and color, which has undergone numerous revisions in subsequent years.

Robe styles vary for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees. The width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increases with each advanced degree. The color of the velvet border on the hood indicates the type of advanced degree achieved.

Undergraduate Honor Cords

Gold signifies summa cum laude, 3.90 or higher cumulative grade point average.

White signifies magna cum laude, 3.70-3.89 cumulative grade point average.

Red signifies cum laude, 3.50-3.69 cumulative grade point average.

To qualify for these honors, students must complete a minimum of 40 cumulative semester hours in baccalaureate coursework or 30 semester hours in associate coursework at Franklin University.
