Dr. Lana K. Uhrig is the vice president of nursing for Winship Cancer Institute of Emory University in Atlanta. Dr. Uhrig leads oncology nursing for Winship across the Emory Healthcare system, overseeing clinical quality, safety, outcomes, education and oncology nursing practice and research.

Dr. Uhrig is a native of southern Ohio and received her associate and bachelor's degrees in nursing from Shawnee State University and Ohio University. She received her MBA from Franklin University, and her master's and a doctorate in public health from The Ohio State University.

She has served in healthcare leadership roles for more than 26 years at the following organizations: Adena Health System, the Ohio State University James Cancer Hospital, the University of Cincinnati Cancer Institute, and Winship Cancer Institute of Emory University. For the past 14 years she has devoted her time and leadership to advancing oncology care both at the bench and bedside. Since 2003, Dr. Uhrig has served as an adjunct professor in the College of Health + Public Administration at Franklin University, and most recently at the Emory School of Nursing. • ROBERT L. BAILEY TEACHING AWARD •

Each trimester, two faculty members are honored with the Robert L. Bailey Teaching Award. Graduating students are asked to identify one undergraduate and one graduate faculty member who had the most significant influence on them throughout their educational experience at Franklin University. The award recognizes those who have challenged students intellectually and guided them in finding the significance of the course content as it relates to them both personally and professionally.

While more than 100 graduate and undergraduate faculty members are nominated each trimester – clearly showing the magnitude of interaction between students and faculty at Franklin University – the faculty members receiving the most nominations are awarded this honor.

These awards are funded through an endowment established by State Auto Insurance Companies in recognition of Robert L. Bailey, who served State Auto for 28 years in various positions, including president, CEO and chairman, until his retirement in 2000. Bailey is also a past Chair and a Trustee Emeritus of Franklin University's Board of Trustees.

Dr. Amy Eaton has been an adjunct professor at Franklin University for nearly 20 years. During that time, she has facilitated courses in professional foundations, human resource management, business administration and applied management.

Amy earned her bachelor's degree in business administration with a focus on human resource management and psychology. She also holds an MBA in Organizational Leadership as well as a Certificate of Advanced Graduate Studies in Strategic Human Resources.

Her professional career includes over 25 years of experience in corporate human resources with much of that time focusing on employee benefit plan design, administration and negotiations. Amy has earned several professional designations including Senior Professional in Human Resources, Certified Employee Benefit Specialist, and the SHRM Senior Certified Professional. Additionally, in 2012 she was the recipient of Franklin University's Silver S.T.A.R Award in recognition of her hard work and dedication to our students.

Dr. Brenda L. Jones is the assistant dean for faculty and instruction, supporting student-centered education at all academic levels. A full-time faculty member at Franklin since 2007, Dr. Jones has also taught in Poland, Oman and South Korea. Her teaching style is that of a coach and mentor, inviting learners to be co-constructors of knowledge and the learning experience as they develop career-relevant skills. She has taught a wide variety of courses including undergraduate communication courses and graduate courses in the MBA, Marketing + Communication, and Business Psychology programs.

Brenda earned her Ph.D. in Organizational Communication, with a minor in industrial and organizational psychology, from The Ohio State University. She also holds master's degrees in business psychology and communication. Prior to pursuing a career in higher education, Brenda worked for two international companies, ITW-Nifco and Electronic Data Systems. She has served in several leadership roles for professional association executive boards, as well as Franklin University's Faculty Senate.

• ACADEMIC REGALIA •

Identification of the hood and robe as academic apparel is believed to have originated at the English universities of Oxford and Cambridge during the 13th and 14th centuries. The hoods are thought to be carried over from the times when the monks who operated universities wore them to protect their shaved heads in winter. The robe also may have been necessary for warmth in the unheated buildings frequented by medieval scholars.

Use of the academic robe came to the United States in the 18th century. In 1895, a conference of various university officials adopted a universal code of design and color, which has undergone numerous revisions over the years.

Robe styles vary for the bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees. The width of sleeve borders and length of the hood increases with each advanced degree. The color of the velvet border on the hood indicates the type of advanced degree achieved.

• UNDERGRADUATE HONOR CORDS •

Gold signifies summa cum laude, 3.90 or higher cumulative GPA.

White signifies magna cum laude, 3.70-3.89 cumulative GPA.

Red signifies cum laude, 3.50-3.69 cumulative GPA.

To qualify for these honors, students must complete a minimum of 30 cumulative semester hours in baccalaureate coursework or 20 semester hours in associate coursework at Franklin University.

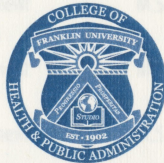
• LEADER SCHOLARS •

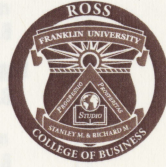

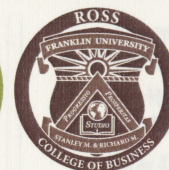
