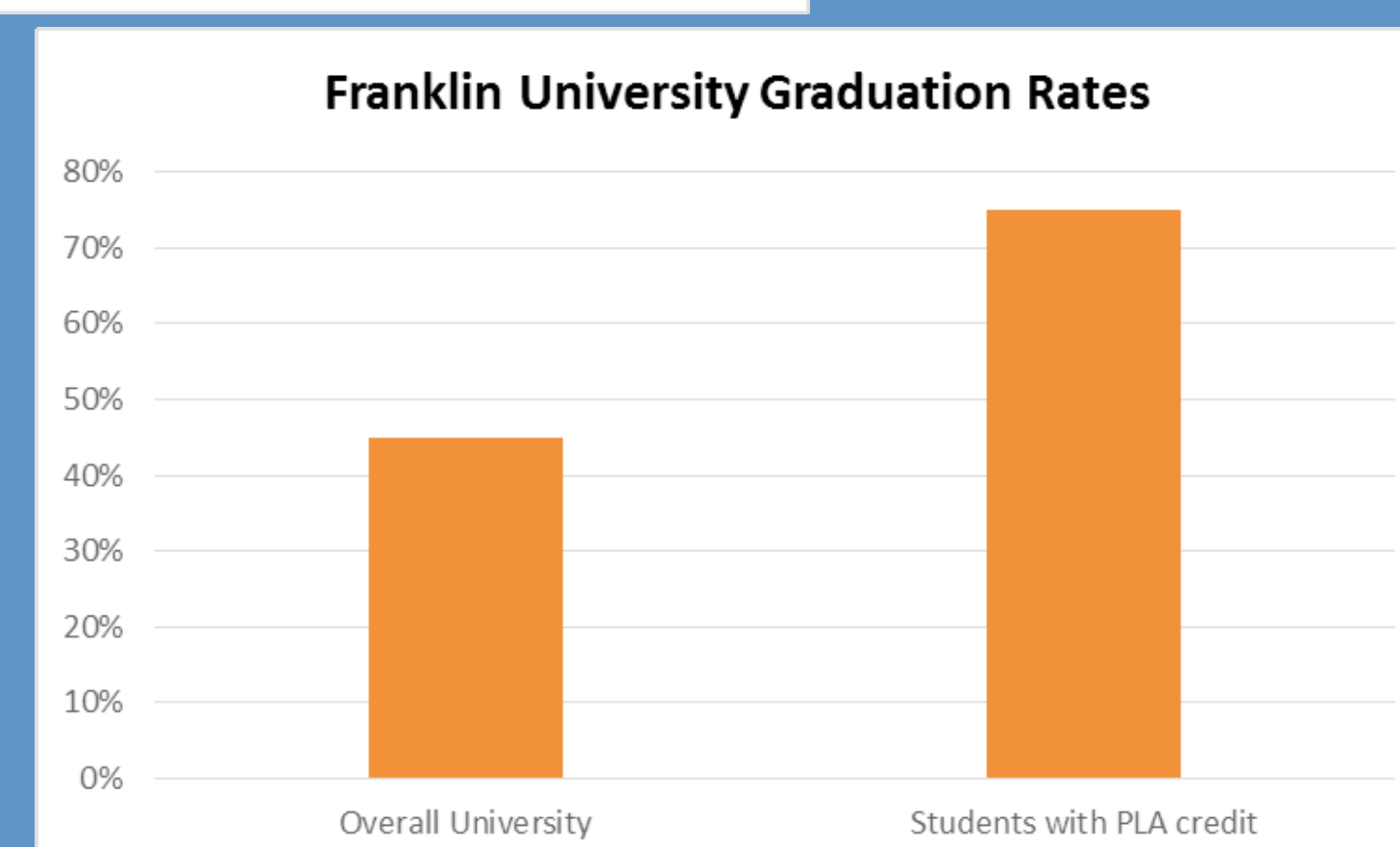
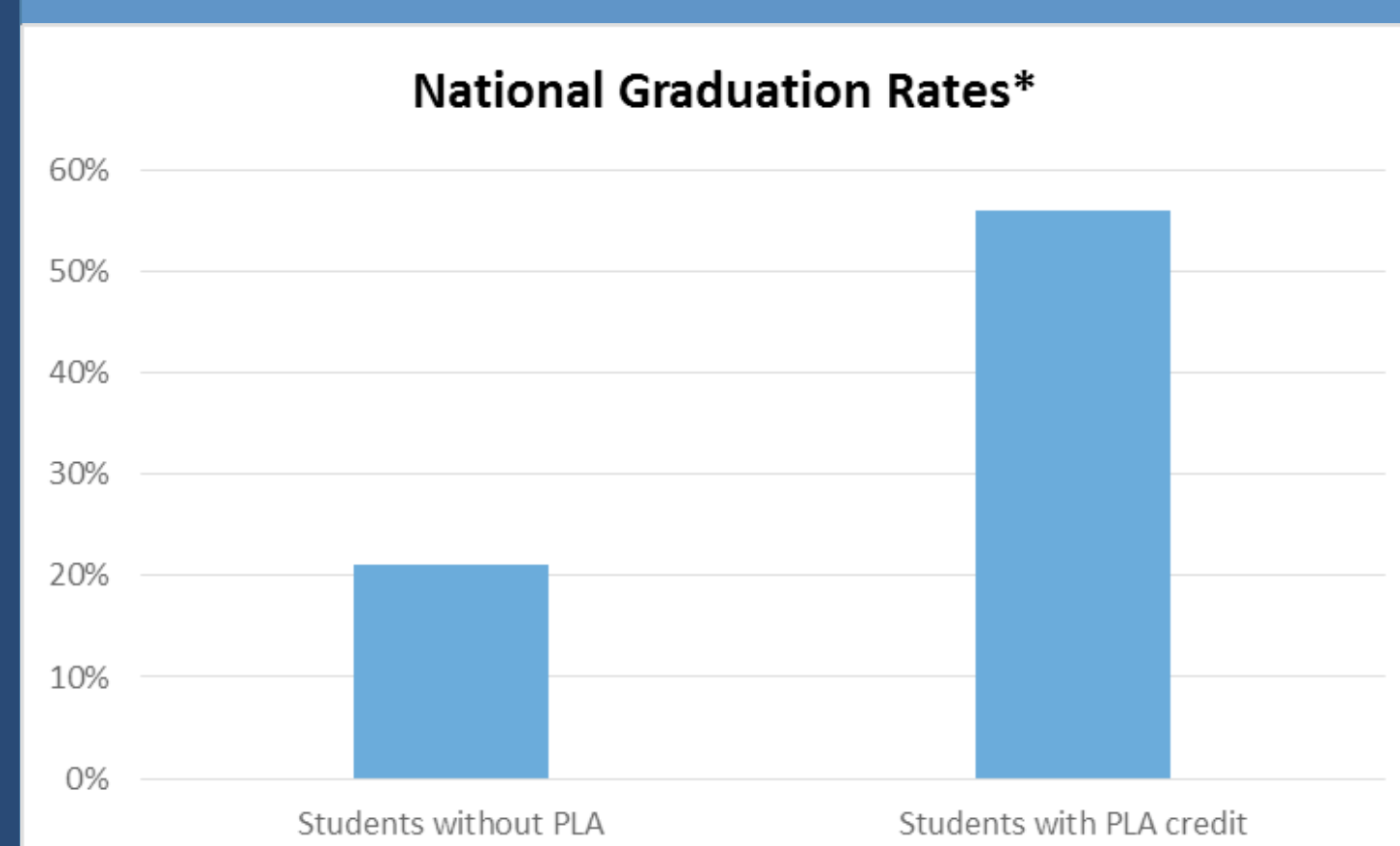

*Note: There is a distinct correlation between the graduation rates and student success. The segment of students earning this type of credit are more successful. It is not assumed that more students taking proficiency examinations will result in higher graduation rates.

A CLEP proficiency exam might be exactly what you're looking for.

The total cost per test is around \$100

The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) provides computer-based, multiple-choice standardized tests that can award students college credit for what they already know. CLEP tests are 90 minutes.

**The College Composition CLEP contains approximately 50 multiple-choice items to be answered in 50 minutes and two mandatory, centrally scored essays to be written in 70 minutes.

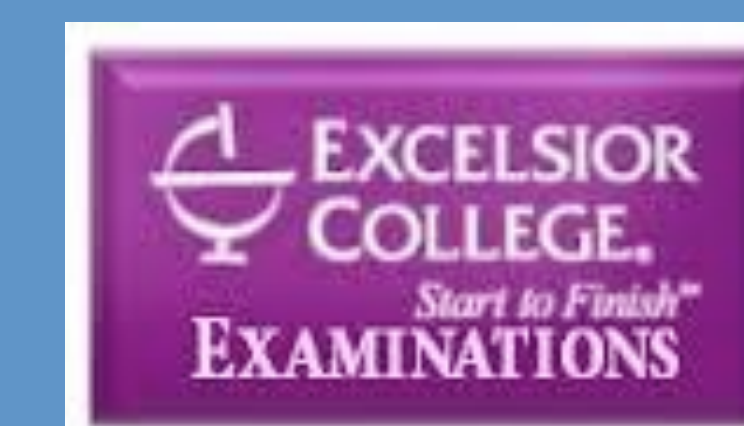
